The curtain opens.

The scene is an early England style tavern, with table and chairs scattered about the interior.

song - **'yo ho'**

The Sailor's Hornpipe is danced during the choruses.

Enter narrator, An 'Old Jim Hawkins'.

SCRIPT INSTRUCTION: Whenever the name of 'Long John Silver' is mentioned, everyone is to call out the pirate catch-cry of "A-YO-HO-HO!" . The first cry is made with much gusto and enthusiasm, but continues to peter out and wane with each successive cry. The final cry is hardly audible and even the cast members do not want to utter the words "Long John Silver".

NARRATOR: I remember it..... as if it was only yesterday; the dancing, the sky-larking, the fun.... Yes, it seems like such a long time ago..... that I went sailing with Long John Silver.....

FULL CAST: A-Yo-Ho-Ho!

NARRATOR: Yes, the crew of the Hispaniola and her quest for Captain Flint's buried Treasure. Oh lookee here, I think I can see one Long John Silver.....

FULL CAST: A-Yo-Ho-Ho!

NARRATOR: He be entering the Admiral Benbow Inn as I speak.

Enter through the swinging inn doors, the rough and ready Long John Silver.

LONG JOHN: Ahoy me mateys, It is I, Long John Silver.

FULL CAST: A Yo-Ho-Ho!

LONG JOHN: Would there be any among you scurvy lot of sea-dogs, that would be willin' to sail the seven seas with your old friend, Long John Silver?
